## Brush Information

### Brush and Bagged Leaves

Brush and bagged leaves are collected once per month as part of the City's monthly brush collection. Tree limbs, brush and shrub trimmings must be piled at the curb and must be free of other debris. Tree limbs must be four (4) feet or less in length and six (6) inches or less in diameter. Thorny-type trimmings must be placed in a separate pile. Please note that the city does not collect grass clippings or garden waste including vines and waste from flower or vegetable gardens.

- Do not tie bags or place lids on containers.
- Do not mix trash with bagged leaves.
- Place bags or containers near the street by 7 a.m. **on Monday** of your collection week.
- If using a container, write "leaves" or "brush" on it so crews can distinguish it from the trash.

### Household hazardous waste and electronics

City of Asheville residents may take their household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronics to the Buncombe County landfill every FRIDAY between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. at a special drop-off area at the Landfill, excluding weeks with a holiday. Businesses will also be able to drop off electronics, but special arrangements need to be made prior to acceptance. Contact the Solid Waste Department (828.250.5462) prior to arrival. Businesses are assessed a fee for electronics recycling. Proof of County residence is required. Paint and paint-related items such as water sealer, paint thinners, enamels and polyurethane will be charged at \$2.00 per gallon.
